

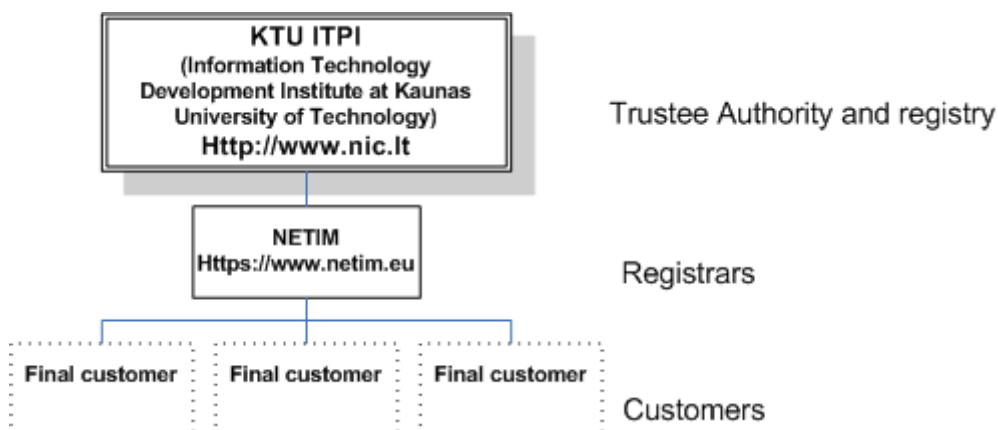
ANNEXE LT - SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR THE ccTLD .LT

In addition to the general terms and conditions CG-ND, the registration or use of a Domain Name in a .LT Extension implies the acceptance and respect of these special terms and conditions CP-ND-LT.

All terms employed in these special terms and conditions beginning with a capital letter are to be interpreted in compliance with the definition assigned to them in the general terms and conditions CG-ND.

SECTION LT.1: TRUSTEE AUTHORITY AND REGISTRY

LT.1.1 The following diagram shows the different operators and the naming system for this Extension



LT.1.2 NETIM is accredited by **KTU ITPI** (also referred to as "NICLT") and act as an official registrar for the management of .LT domain names

SECTION LT.2: REGISTRATION REGULATIONS

LT.2.1 Domain Names under this Extension are registered on a "*first come, first served*" basis

LT.2.2 The Client declares and guarantees that the Domain Name respects the rights of third-parties, currently applicable laws as well as the regulations specific to the Extension, which can be consulted at the following addresses:

The Client agrees to have read and accepted this contractual document (the "NICLT Regulations" below) which links him to the NICLT Registry. These special terms and conditions do not substitute these regulations which are integrated by means of a hyperlink.

SECTION LT.3: TRANSFER REGULATIONS

LT.3.1 The Client initiates through the intermediary of NETIM a transfer request for a Domain Name in .LT from another registrar to NETIM (also referred to as "incoming transfer"), according to the procedure specified on our site, and in compliance with NICLT Regulations:

LT.3.2 The transfer does not take effect immediately. The Client must follow the described procedure and, particularly, must authorize the transfer at the registry following the format specified on the Registry's Website.

LT.3.3 If the Client refuses or does not authorize the transfer according to the terms stipulated by the Registry, the transfer cannot be proceeded with and the Client may not claim any compensation or refund from NETIM

SECTION LT.4: EXPIRY / RESTORATION REGULATIONS

LT.4.1 When the Domain Name's expiry date has passed without prior renewal by the Client, NETIM shall submit a request for the deletion of the Domain Name to the Registry. The Domain Name shall then be disabled for a period of thirty (30) calendar days during which all NETIM's associated services shall no longer be available. The Domain Name shall be referred to as in "quarantine" status

LT.4.2 If a Domain Name has been destroyed with the past thirty (30) calendar days, it can be registered again subject to the following conditions and procedures, and depending on the details provided to NETIM when carrying out these procedures:

- i) restoration is only possible from a technical point of view for the so-called "quarantine" period, which is the thirty (30) day period between the destruction of the Domain Name by NETIM and its destruction by the Registry
- ii) payment for the restoration must be made seven (7) days before the destruction of the Domain Name by the Registry, to enable NETIM to carry out the operation within the time limit. Failing this, the Domain Name might not be restored and NETIM cannot be held responsible on these grounds.
- iii) the restoration procedure restores the Domain Name's previous parameters (personal and technical information) and extends by one (1) year the duration of the Domain Name's registration starting from the end of the restoration procedure.

SECTION LT.5: CONTRACTUAL AMENDMENTS FOR SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

LT.5.1 Regulation laid down by the Trustee Authority and the Registry are subject to change. These changes, linked to the naming system for .LT extensions are imposed by NICLT in charge of this Extension and represent changes that are not beyond NETIM's control.
