

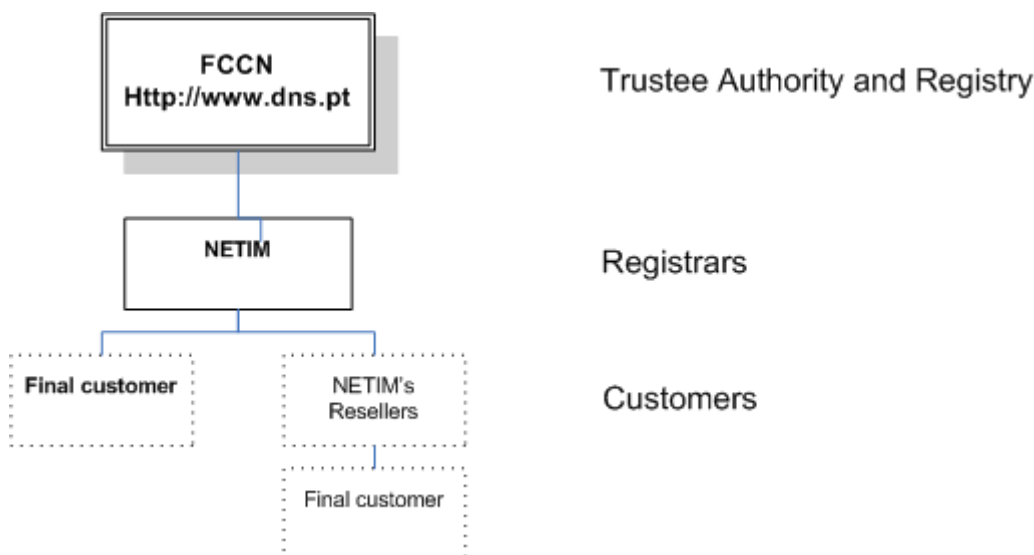
## ANNEXE PT - SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR THE ccTLD .PT

In addition to the general terms and conditions CG-ND, the registration or use of a Domain Name in a .PT Extension implies the acceptance and respect of these special terms and conditions CP-ND-PT.

All terms employed in these special terms and conditions beginning with a capital letter are to be interpreted in compliance with the definition assigned to them in the general terms and conditions CG-ND.

### SECTION PT.1: TRUSTEE AUTHORITY AND REGISTRY

PT.1.1 The following diagram shows the different operators and the naming system for this Extension



PT.1.2 NETIM act as an accredited registrar for the management of .PT domain names.

### SECTION PT.2: REGISTRATION REGULATIONS

PT.2.1 Domain Names under this Extension are registered on a "*first come, first served*" basis

PT.2.2 The Client declares and guarantees that the Domain Name respects the rights of third-parties, currently applicable laws as well as the regulations specific to the Extension, which can be consulted at the following addresses:

The Client agrees to have read and accepted this contractual document (the "PT Regulations" below) which links him to the Registry. These special terms and conditions do not substitute these regulations which are integrated by means of a hyperlink.

PT.2.3 The registration of a Domain Name in .COM.PT is not restricted.

PT.2.4 The registration of a Domain Name in .PT is restricted to organizations, whatever the country, that have a right on the name, (the domain name must coincide with the owner's name, business name, or trademark valid in Portugal).

### SECTION PT.3: TRANSFER REGULATIONS

PT.3.1 The Client initiates through the intermediary of NETIM a transfer request for a Domain Name in .PT or .COM.PT from another registrar to NETIM (also referred to as "incoming transfer"), according to the procedure specified on our site, and in compliance with PT Regulations:

PT.3.2 The client must follow the described procedure and, particularly, must provide a valid authorization code to NETIM. Otherwise the transfer cannot be proceeded with and the Client may not claim any compensation or refund from NETIM

PT.3.3 The transfer to NETIM does not include any renewal for the Domain Name.

PT.4 In the context of a transfer of a Domain Name to another Registrar , the authorisation codes can be obtained in the Interface and are sent by electronic mail to the Client's email address.

#### **SECTION PT.4: CHANGE of OWNERSHIP REGULATIONS**

PT.4.1 According to PT Regulations, changes of ownership are prohibited for Domain Names in .COM.PT

PT.4.2 Requests for a change of ownership concerning Domain Names in .PT must be done directly with the Registry by following the procedures in force at <https://online.dns.pt/site/publico>

#### **SECTION PT.5: EXPIRY / RESTORATION REGULATIONS**

PT.5.1 When the Domain Name's expiry date has passed without prior renewal by the Client, NETIM shall submit a request for the deletion of the Domain Name to the Registry. The Domain Name shall then be disabled for a period of twenty five (25) calendar days during which all NETIM's associated services shall no longer be available. The Domain Name shall be referred to as in "pending delete" status

PT.5.2 If a Domain Name is in the "pending delete" status, it can be reactivated subject to the following conditions and procedures, and depending on the details provided to NETIM when carrying out these procedures:

- i) reactivation is only possible from a technical point of view for the period between the expiration of the Domain Name and its destruction by the Registry
- ii) payment for the reactivation must be made two (2) days before the destruction of the Domain Name by the Registry, to enable NETIM to carry out the operation within the time limit. Failing this, the Domain Name might not be reactivated and NETIM cannot be held responsible on these grounds.
- iii) the reactivation procedure restores the Domain Name's previous parameters (personal and technical information) and extends by one (1) year the duration of the Domain Name's registration starting from the previous expiry date.

#### **SECTION PT.6: CONTRACTUAL AMENDMENTS FOR SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

PT.6.1 Regulation laid down by the Trustee Authority and the Registry are subject to change. These changes, linked to the naming system for .PT extensions are imposed by FCCN in charge of this Extension and represent changes that are not beyond NETIM's control.
