

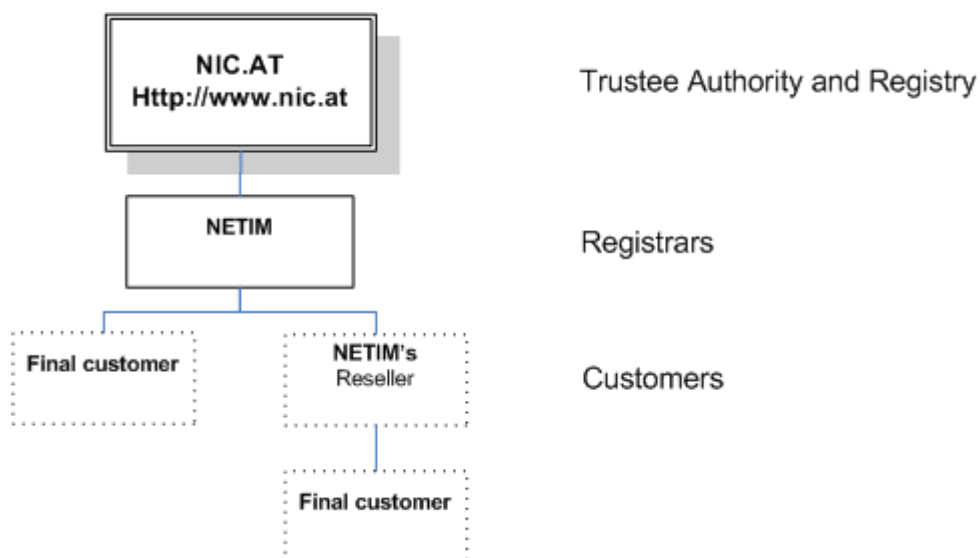
ANNEX AT - SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR THE ccTld .AT

In addition to the general terms and conditions CG-ND, the registration or use of a Domain Name in a .AT Extension implies the acceptance and respect of these special terms and conditions CP-ND-AT.

All terms employed in these special terms and conditions beginning with a capital letter are to be interpreted in compliance with the definition assigned to them in the general terms and conditions CG-ND.

CLAUSE AT.1: TRUSTEE AUTHORITY AND REGISTRY

AT.1.1 The following diagram shows the different operators and the naming system for this Extension



AT.1.2 NETIM is accredited by Nic.AT and act as an official registrar for the management of .AT domain names

CLAUSE AT.2: REGISTRATION REGULATIONS

AT.2.1 Domain Names under this Extension are registered on a "*first come, first served*" basis, unless if exception is made by the registry (i.e. for prohibited or reserved terms).

AT.2.2 The Client declares and guarantees that the Domain Name respects the rights of third-parties, currently applicable laws as well as the regulations specific to the Extension, which can be consulted at the following addresses:

The Client agrees to have read and accepted these contractual documents (the "NICAT Regulations" below) which bind him to the Registry. These special terms and conditions do not substitute these regulations which are integrated by means of a hyperlink.

AT.2.3 As long as your domain name is managed by NETIM, your obligation to pay the Registry for your domain name is suspended.

In the unusual event that the domain name is released from NETIM and sent to the Registry for management, you will be obliged to pay the Registry directly for the registration of domain name thereafter, according to their rates (http://www.nic.at/en/faq/billing_prices/), unless you can find another Registrar to manage your domain name before your payment to the Registry is due.

CLAUSE AT.3: TRANSFER REGULATIONS

AT.3.1 The Client initiates through the intermediary of NETIM a transfer request for a Domain Name in .AT from another registrar to NETIM (also referred to as "incoming transfer"), according to the procedure specified on our site, and in compliance with NICAT Regulations:

AT.3.2 The incoming transfer does not take effect immediately. The Client must follow the described procedure and, particularly, must approve the transfer to the registry following the format specified.

AT.3.3 If the Client refuses or does not approve the incoming transfer according to the terms stipulated by the Registry, the transfer cannot be proceeded with and the Client may not claim any compensation or refund from NETIM.

AT.3.4 The transfer to NETIM does not include any renewal for the Domain Name.

CLAUSE AT.4: CHANGE of OWNERSHIP REGULATIONS

AT.4.1 The Client initiates, through the intermediary of NETIM, a request for a change of ownership for a Domain Name in .AT.

AT.4.2 The change does not take effect immediately. The Client must provide the application form and the needed proof of identity to NETIM by the way of his choice. The application will be checked and approved by the sole discretion of NETIM.

AT.4.3 If the Client does not provide a correct application, the change cannot be proceeded with and the Client may not claim any compensation or refund from NETIM.

AT.4.4 The change of ownership does not include any renewal for the Domain Name.

CLAUSE AT.5: EXPIRY / RESTORATION REGULATIONS

AT.5.1 Following the NICAT Regulations, NETIM must request the deletion of the Domain Name 28 days before its expiry date to ensure that, in case of non-renewal, expiration is effective. Then the Domain Name shall be referred to as in "locked" status. In case of renewal by the Client, the removal request is canceled and the Domain Name is unlocked.

AT.5.2 When the Domain Name's expiry date has passed without prior renewal by the Client, the Domain Name shall then be disabled for a period of fifty nine (59) calendar days during which all NETIM's associated services shall no longer be available.

AT.5.3 If a domain name is still not renewed at the end of the period of fifty nine (59) calendar days, the Domain Name is permanently removed the next day.

CLAUSE AT.6: CONTRACTUAL AMENDMENTS FOR SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

AT.6.1 Regulation laid down by the Trustee Authority and the Registry are subject to change. These changes, linked to the naming system for .AT extensions are imposed by the Registry in charge of this Extension and represent changes that are not beyond NETIM's control.
