
ANNEXE GR - SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR THE EXTENSION .GR

In addition to the general terms and conditions CG-ND, the registration or use of a Domain Name in a .GR Extension implies the acceptance and respect of these special terms and conditions CP-ND-GR.

All terms employed in these special terms and conditions beginning with a capital letter are to be interpreted in compliance with the definition assigned to them in the general terms and conditions CG-ND.

CLAUSE GR.1: TRUSTEE AUTHORITY AND REGISTRY

GR.1.1 The following diagram shows the different operators and the naming system for these Extensions



GR.1.2. NETIM act as an accredited registrar of E.E.T.T for the management of .GR domain names.

CLAUSE GR.2: REGISTRATION REGULATIONS

GR.2.1 The Client declares and guarantees that the Domain Name respects the rights of third-parties, all currently applicable laws and regulations as well as the regulations concerning Extension, defined by the Registry and consultable at the following addresses:

The Client agrees to have read and accepted these contractual documents (below, the "NICGR Regulations") which link him to the Registry. These special terms and conditions do not substitute these regulations which are integrated by means of a hyperlink.

- GR.2.2 The registration does not take effect immediately. The Client must provide the application form to NETIM by the way of his choice. The application will be checked and approved by the sole discretion of NETIM.
- GR.2.3 If the Client does not provide the application form, the registration cannot be proceeded with and the Client may not claim any compensation or refund from NETIM.
- GR.2.4 After registration of the Domain Name, pursuant to the NICGR Regulations, the registry will make the approval or rejection of the registration within 20 days. If rejected, the Client accepts that the Domain Name be deleted by the registry and may not claim any compensation or refund from NETIM.

CLAUSE GR.3: TRANSFER REGULATIONS

GR.3.1 The Client initiates, through the intermediary of NETIM, a request for transfer of a Domain Name from another Registrar to NETIM, following the procedure specified on our site and in compliance with NICGR Regulations:

GR.3.2 The client must follow the described procedure and, particularly, must provide a valid authorization code to NETIM. Otherwise the transfer cannot be proceeded with and the Client may not claim any compensation or refund from NETIM

GR.3.3 The transfer to NETIM does not include any renewal for the Domain Name.

GR.3.4 In the context of a transfer of a Domain Name to another Registrar, the authorisation code can be obtained in the Interface and is sent by electronic mail to the Client's email address.

CLAUSE GR.4: EXPIRY / RESTORATION REGULATIONS

GR.4.1 When the Domain Name's expiry date has passed without prior renewal by the Client, NETIM shall submit a request for the deletion of the Domain Name to the Registry. The Domain Name shall then be disabled for a period of fourteen (14) calendar days during which all NETIM's associated services shall no longer be available. The Domain Name shall be referred to as in "quarantine" status

GR.4.2 If a Domain Name has been destroyed with the past fourteen (14) calendar days, it can be reactivated subject to the following conditions and procedures, and depending on the details provided to NETIM when carrying out these procedures:

- i) restoration is only possible from a technical point of view for the so-called "quarantine" period, which is the fourteen (14) day period between the destruction of the Domain Name by NETIM and its destruction by the Registry
- the restoration procedure restores the Domain Name's previous parameters (personal and technical information) and extends by two (2) years the duration of the Domain Name's registration starting from the restoration date.

CLAUSE GR.5: CONTRACTUAL AMENDMENTS FOR SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

GR.5.1 The regulations laid down by the Trustee Authority and the Registry are subject to change. These changes, linked to the naming system for .GR extension, are imposed by the Registry in charge of this Extension and represent changes that are not beyond NETIM's control.
