

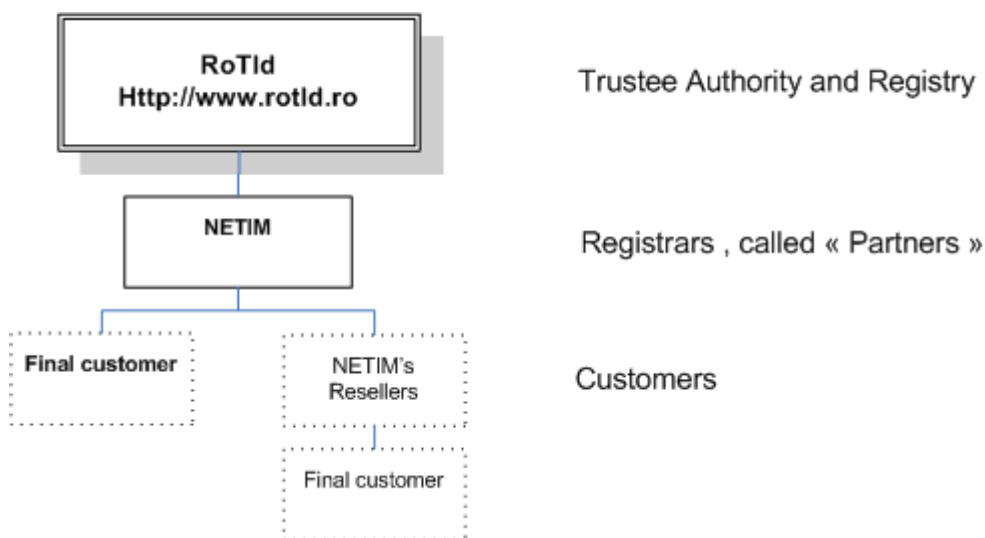
ANNEXE RO - SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR THE ccTLD .RO

In addition to the general terms and conditions CG-ND, the registration or use of a Domain Name in a .RO Extension implies the acceptance and respect of these special terms and conditions CP-ND-RO.

All terms employed in these special terms and conditions beginning with a capital letter are to be interpreted in compliance with the definition assigned to them in the general terms and conditions CG-ND.

SECTION RO.1: TRUSTEE AUTHORITY AND REGISTRY

RO.1.1 The following diagram shows the different operators and the naming system for this Extension



RO.1.2 NETIM acts as an official partner of RoTld for the management of .RO domain names.

SECTION RO.2: REGISTRATION REGULATIONS

RO.2.1 Domain Names under this Extension are registered on a "*first come, first served*" basis.

RO.2.2 The Client declares and guarantees that the Domain Name respects the rights of third-parties, currently applicable laws as well as the regulations specific to the Extension, which can be consulted at the following addresses:

The Client agrees to have read and accepted these contractual documents (the "RO Regulations" below) which links him to the Registry. These special terms and conditions do not substitute these regulations which are integrated by means of a hyperlink.

RO.2.3 According to the RO Regulations, registering a domain name in .RO is made for life to the given holder.

RO.2.4 In order to allow the management of a Domain Name by NETIM on behalf of the Client, the owner's email address will be the NETIM's one without possibility for the Client to amend this information. However the Client can withdraw the management of the Domain Name from NETIM as described in section RO.3.2

ARTICLE RO.3 : CONDITIONS PARTICULIERES

RO.3.1 According to section RO.2.3, the Client acknowledges that the use of services provided by NETIM, i.e. the management of a Domain Name in .RO, is a service requiring a billing. An expiration date is assigned to the Domain Name by NETIM and can be extended by a renewal process at the rates in force. In case of failure to renew, all services associated with NETIM will be no longer available.

RO.3.2 The Client can request the release of the Domain Name by NETIM in order to manage it by himself directly at the registry. The application must be made by the Client directly to NETIM by contacting support.

During a release, NETIM performs the followings:

- Amendment of the owner's email address for the Client's one
- Amendment of the technical contact for the Client
- deletion of NETIM's DNS servers that can be assigned to the Domain Name
- sending the password to access the administration interface on the Registry's website.

The Client acknowledges that a release is considered as an outgoing transfer. NETIM will no longer be the entity responsible for managing the Domain Name.

RO.3.3 The Client can request the removal of the Domain Name to NETIM by following the procedure in force. The application must be made by the Client directly to NETIM by contacting support.

RO.3.4 According to the RO Regulations, the transfer of registrar or partner doesn't exist. Only the terms of sections RO.3.2 and RO.3.3 may apply.

CLAUSE RO.4: CHANGE of OWNERSHIP REGULATIONS

RO.4.1 The Client initiates, through the intermediary of NETIM, a request for a change of ownership for a Domain Name in .RO.

RO.4.2 The change does not take effect immediately. The Client must follow the described procedure and, particularly, must approve the transfer to the registry following a format specified on the Registry's Website at <http://portal.rotld.ro/pages/en/8/>

RO.4.3 If the Client refuses or does not approve the change of ownership according to the terms stipulated by the Registry, the change cannot be proceeded with and the Client may not claim any compensation or refund from NETIM

SECTION RO.5: CONTRACTUAL AMENDMENTS FOR SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

RO.5.1 Regulation laid down by the Trustee Authority and the Registry are subject to change. These changes, linked to the naming system for .RO extensions are imposed by Nominet in charge of this Extension and represent changes that are not beyond NETIM's control.
